- Found rescue (MLAR) for Bella, Chin Chin and Flynn (dogs), when their ill and elderly dad passed away. Two were adopted, one is in a forever foster home with MLAR.
- Found a temporary foster for a dog whose mom was hospitalized.
- Helped a homebound senior client adopt a cat from a local rescue after she lost her beloved cat of 15 years.
- Helped place two cats that needed to be only cats into foster care with two of our seniors.
